## INFERNO DESTROYS BEST SPRINTERS IN LION CITY CUP



*Inferno annihilates his rivals in the Group 1 Lion City Cup on Sunday.*

The epithets may be running scarce but a few unused glowing terms still came out in praise of **Inferno** (Holy Roman Emperor) following his exhibition gallop in the S\$400,000 Lion City Cup (1200m) on Sunday.

In his typically economical debriefing style after the country's premier sprint, trainer Cliff Brown said the Holy Roman Emperor four-year-old was "something else".

A few minutes later, after emerging from the jockeys' room, Vlad Duric said he had never ridden any horse quite like Inferno in Singapore.

Brown had expressed some misgivings about the drop from the mile at his last victory in the Singapore Guineas (1600m) on September 26 to the six furlongs, taking on the cream of the sprinting crop at Kranji, mostly seasoned competitors at level weights, for the first time.

The Australian needn't have lost sleep over it.

Given a peach of a ride by Duric in his customary rearward spot, Inferno had "winner" written all over the moment he was

squeezed for his trademark peripheral launch from the 600m.

Zac Kasa (Reset) was being hailed the winner when he hit the lead with 300m to go, but for all his gameness, and that of the other closers – like eventual runner-up Mr Malek (NZ) (Swiss Ace), they were left clutching at straws when Inferno, the 2018 Karaka Book 1 sale graduate from the Westbury Stud draft, ran on by.

Eased down towards the line, Inferno had two and a quarter lengths to spare from Mr Malek with a slick winning time of 1min 8.28secs for the 1200m.

Not one given to exuberant post-race reactions, Brown still showed his huge relief, especially after he knew he had pushed the envelope for that extraordinary winner of eight races from nine. Clearly, he is carrying the mantle of heir apparent Brown's and Barree's just-retired iconic champion Debt Collector (NZ) (Thorn Park) very well.

"He's quite something else, isn't he?" said Brown in sheer admiration of the effortless manner Inferno put some of the best sprinters at Kranji to the sword.

"To come back from the mile to

1200m, it's very hard to do, but he did a great job. This horse is just getting better and better.

"I'm very pleased. I'll wait a while and decide what next, but to be honest, I'm not sure what is next for him.

"There isn't much left for him. We may wait for a Class 1 race or we may even give him a break, we'll see how he pulls up."

With that facile win in the Lion City Cup, Inferno has now amassed around S\$1.1 million in stakes money for the Barree Stable.

# CONCERT HALL ALL CLASS AT TRENTHAM

It may have taken nearly all of the Trentham straight to get her head in front but class performer **Concert Hall (NZ)** (Savabeel) delivered when it counted as she took out the Gr.3 Gee & Hickton Funeral Directors Thompson Handicap (1600m) on Sunday.

Sent out a warm favourite after producing a storming finish for second at Ellerslie when opening her latest campaign, the Savabeel mare delivered for her supporters despite giving them a few heart flutters along the way.

Rider Ryan Elliot had her ticking along nicely towards the rear of a compact field early on before being asked to make her run wide out approaching the home corner.

With the earlier races favouring the inside runners it looked like the Roger James and Robert Wellwood-trained six-year-old might come up short in her winning bid after lightweight runner Vent (NZ) (Haradasun) still had a two-length advantage with 200m to run.

Elliot asked the mare for her best and she put in some massive bounds to level up to Vent short of the winning post before putting her head in front where it counted to collect career win number seven and her third at stakes level.

"She's an exciting mare and she has backed up a super run

first-up with her performance today," Robert Wellwood said.

"She's a mare that has kept improving with maturity and it looks like she has stepped up again for this season.

"She's a real race horse who wants to be there and you could see that as she really pinned her ears back at the 200m and got down to her task.

"We'll see how she travels back and comes through the race but we do have some exciting targets for her.

"We had thought about running her at Pukekohe next week if it got too wet at Trentham today, but now she has had that run we will just tick her along.

"A race like the Counties Cup (Gr.3, 2100m) is an option that is coming up but if she does what we think she can do then a trip across the Tasman for an autumn campaign is a definite option."

Bred and raced by noted Waikato breeder Joan Egan, Concert Hall is out of four-race winner Classic Legacy and hails from an extended family that includes multiple Group One winners Arena (Danehill) and Tartan Tights (NZ) (Tights).

The victory was Concert Hall's second at Group Three level at Trentham having taken out the 2019 Gr.3 Cuddle Stakes (1600m) there while she also won the Gr.3 Manawatu Cup

(2300m) at Awapuni in December last year.

# DECISIONS TO BE MADE ON DRAGON'S DIRECTION

**A** comprehensive five-length victory over 3000m by **Dragon Storm (NZ)** (Shocking) at Riccarton on Saturday has created an interesting conundrum for his trainer Chris Gibbs.

Gibbs, who prepares the six-year-old in partnership with Michelle Bradley, sent his charge south with an eye on a start in the Gr.3 Christchurch Casino New Zealand Cup (3200m) next month however Saturday's win has opened up an opportunity to compete in the unique A\$304,000 Jericho Cup (4600m) at Warrnambool in late November.

The Jericho Cup is a race that was introduced in 2018 to commemorate the centenary of a race run on the desert sands in Palestine in World War I to divert attention from the Australian Light Horse's charge at Beersheba and is restricted to Australian and New Zealand bred horses to honour the spirit of the ANZACs.

The inaugural event at Warrnambool was won by New Zealand bred son of Redwood, High Mode (NZ), while former Kiwi Ablaze (NZ) (Raise The Flag) proved too good last year.

Saturday's Riccarton race was the

second New Zealand qualifying event for the Jericho Cup with the first being taken out by Master Fin (NZ) (Nom Du Jeu) at New Plymouth last month. Dragon Storm has now guaranteed himself a start at Warrnambool should his connections decide to make the trip.

"I guess it's a nice problem to have as he has probably guaranteed himself a start in the New Zealand Cup as well as the Jericho," Gibbs said.

"I will have a talk to the owners on Monday once we see how he pulls

up but by all accords he has come through well.

"My initial thought is that we push on to the New Zealand Cup as he is in good form, he likes the track and the money is good, so we go there and worry about the other race after that."

Gibbs was pleased to see Dragon Storm back to winning form after tweaking his training regime for this campaign.

"We're touching new ground a little bit with him this time as I've trained him a little bit differently and kept him a lot fresher," he said.

"He was very dominant on Saturday which was pleasing.

"I knew he'd get the distance but it was really whether anything else could come up and grab him once he got to the front in the straight.

"He had them all well covered in the end which should stand him in good stead for his next assignment.

"He should get into the New Zealand Cup with a light weight and we know he will certainly run the trip right out."

By Gr.1 Melbourne Cup (3200m) winner Shocking out of dual Gr.1 Auckland Cup (3200m) winner Prize Lady, Dragon Storm has now won four of his 22 starts.

He currently sits at 22nd on the order of entry for the New Zealand Cup before any rating penalty for

Saturday's win and is listed as an \$8 chance on the TAB Fixed odds market behind joint favourites Communique (NZ) (Redwood) (\$6) and Gorbachev (NZ) (Gorky Park) (\$6), with the former a doubtful starter and more likely to head to the Gr.2 Coupland's Bakeries Mile (1600m).

Gibbs also advised that he would be operating in his own right from November 1 after Bradley handed in her notice to him recently.

"Michelle has handed in her notice so I'll be on my own from the end of this month," he said.

"We've told all of our owners now and we are parting on excellent terms.

"Michelle wants to spend some more time with her family and I'm sure

she will have some plans of her own, but for me it will just be business as usual." – **NZ Racing Desk**

# PITMAN FILLY READY FOR CLASSIC CHALLENGE

**O**n a day where the contenders for the upcoming age-group classics at Riccarton were on display around the country, South Island galloper **Miss Tycoon Rose** (Written Tycoon) threw her hat in the ring with an impressive maiden victory.

The Michael and Matthew Pitman-trained three-year-old was backed off the map in the first event at Riccarton on Saturday as she reverted to maiden company after producing an eye-catching late run for fifth in the Listed Canterbury Belle Stakes (1400m) at her previous start.

The Written Tycoon filly didn't disappoint as she announced her candidacy for the Gr.1 Barneswood Farm New Zealand 1000 Guineas (1600m) on November 14 with a stylish five-length victory in a slick 1.23.43 for the 1400m journey.

"We've been very happy with how she is going and hopefully she has done enough now to get a start in the 1000 Guineas," Michael Pitman said.

"Obviously, the punters thought she was a good thing yesterday and she proved that in the end."

"I think the most impressive part of the win was the time she ran as that would be competitive against the best three-year-old fillies."

While Pitman is bullish about her future prospects, it hasn't always been that way after he outlaid \$40,000 to purchase her from the Berkley Stud draft during the 2019 Book 2 Yearling Sale at Karaka.

"She's a big improver as when I first trialled her, I couldn't wait to get rid of her," he said.

"We gave her a trial over 450m at Motukarara and she did absolutely nothing."

"I dropped her off at Berkley Stud on the way home and she had a good break there. When she came back in, she was just a different horse."

"She was just weak and needed time to grow but she has kept improving all the way through."

"She deserves her chance in the Guineas as she has always found the line, so I don't think the mile will be a worry."

"The other great thing about her is that the people who own her are also in a number of other horses with me and I've trained for them a long long time."

"They come from all over New Zealand and I think they are all coming down for Cup Week."

The Pitman team is also likely to have two runners in the first three-year-old classic of Christchurch Cup Week with the erratic but talented Ocean Park gelding Marine (NZ) set to take his place in the Gr.1 Al Basti Equiworld Dubai New Zealand 2000 Guineas (1600m) alongside stablemate Watchmaker (NZ) (Pins).

Marine finished second in Saturday's Gr.3 War Decree Stakes (1600m) but spoilt his chances by lugging in badly in the home straight.

"Every time he has lined up it seems to be in the slowest race of the day and he just gets himself into trouble as he wants to go quicker," Pitman said.

"The good thing about the 2000 Guineas is that they always run it at a true pace which will suit him nicely."

"He is going super and he should be very competitive."

"His stablemate Watchmaker also deserves his chance in the race and he is going great guns as well."

"He will be a worthy back-up as he does everything right and has been running great sectionals in his latest races."

While Pitman is looking forward to racing on his home patch over Cup Week, he is also gearing up for the upcoming New Zealand Bloodstock Ready To Run Sale of Two-year-olds at Karaka on November 18 & 19.

"Our stable is really firing at the moment so it's a good time to get up to Karaka and try and buy some more quality types," he said.

"We're just trying to put together a syndicate to buy three horses so that will be very exciting once Cup Week is over."

# RAE'S PHONE RED HOT AFTER SPEEDY JUVENILE WINS AGAIN



Follow Your Dreams makes it two wins on end with a front-running victory at Riccarton (Race Images South)

**B**ack to back victories by promising two-year-old **Follow Your Dreams (NZ)** (Contributer) has trainer Kenny Rae's telephone running red hot.

The speedy son of Mapperley Stud-based sire Contributer set tongues wagging after his first-up win over 800m at Riccarton earlier this month and he backed that up with an even more decisive effort over the same distance on Saturday.

Rae, who trains in partnership with

his daughter Krystal Williams-Tuhoro, has been fielding offers for the stylish colt since he first stepped out at the trials back in August, but has had a simple message for the bloodstock agents who have been contacting him – the colt is not for sale.

"I've had one joker chasing him since he first won a trial but the owners have always said to me, I'm not to sell him," Rae said.

"I actually own thirty percent of him but his other owners have all been

with me a long time and loyalty counts for plenty in this game.

"Money isn't everything and everyone is having a ball so far and they want that ride to continue."

Rae admits he wasn't as confident of a victory on Saturday as he had been first up after the colt became cast in his yard leading into the race.

"Watching a replay of the race it looked easier than it did watching it live," Rae said.

"I had some doubts as he got cast in his yard the other day and took a wee bit of bark off so it was touch and go whether we lined up.

"He also got a bit scratchy towards the end but that was to be expected as the track was pretty firm.

"He seems fine this morning though so I expect him to come through the race well."

Rae now has a decision to make on where he goes next with the colt as he had originally planned for an attack on the Listed Frantic Bloodstock Welcome Stakes (1000m) on November 14 but that could be changed in favour of bigger fish in January.

"He's qualified himself for the Karaka Million (1200m) at Ellerslie in January now so we are going to have a rethink about our plans with him," he said.

"We had been thinking about the Welcome Stakes but we might forego that now.

"I'll know in a couple of days once we've had a good talk about it all but we could take him home and throw him in the paddock and then bring him back for Ellerslie.

"He is very professional so all he would need is a look around Ellerslie beforehand and then he could go straight into the Karaka Million."

Rae had been hoping to have promising three-year-old Zoltan (NZ) (Iffraaj) line up in the Gr.1 Al Basti Equiworld Dubai New Zealand 2000 Guineas (1600m) at Riccarton on November 7 but the lingering effects of his spectacular fall at Ashburton at his last start has seen that plan taken off the table.

"He's got a fetlock injury and hasn't come right yet," Rae said.

"It's a bit niggly so we're having him x-rayed on Tuesday to take another look at it.

"He's very tough, and you'd have to be to come through a fall like that, but there is no way we can get him to the 2000 Guineas now."

Rae also advised that fourteen-race winner Kaharau (Ad Valorem)

has been retired while his other Gr.3 Christchurch Casino New Zealand Cup (3200m) contender Major Tom (NZ) (Red Giant) would have one more run at Ashburton next Thursday before taking his place in the Riccarton two-mile feature on November 14.
