SINARAHMA SET FOR ANOTHER GROUP ONE TARGET

Although he enjoyed a wonderful day at Trentham on Saturday, trainer Allan Sharrock was left with a niggling feeling of what might have been had his promising mare **Sinarahma (NZ)** (Savabeel) jumped with the field in the Gr.1 Harcourts Thorndon Mile (1600m).

The six-year-old Savabeel mare produced an amazing performance to get within a length of eventual winner Melody Belle (NZ) (Commands) in the Group One feature after missing the start by a conservative ten lengths.

Rider Danielle Johnson did a remarkable job to have Sinarahma within striking distance of the leaders at the 800m before unleashing a powerful finish in the slowest part of the track against the rail in the home straight to narrowly miss victory.

Sharrock later claimed a special win in the Gr.3 NZ Campus of Innovation & Sport Wellington Cup (3200m) with Waisake (NZ) (Zed), but was left rueing the barrier bungle

by Sinarahma in her first attempt at Group One level.

"I've never in forty years seen a horse miss the start by that much and still be in the finish in a Group One race," he said.

"It was an outstanding performance, probably a lifetime best for her.

"She came back in afterwards and she was heavily in season, so I think that explains what happened in the barrier.

"Danielle said she just sat back when the gates opened and that was that.

"We copped a warning on her barrier manners, but she doesn't have to trial or anything like that and I think it might just be a one-off at the worst possible time."

Sharrock will now press ahead to the Gr.1 Herbie Dyke Stakes (2000m) at Te Rapa in a fortnight.

"I've got no option but to go to the Herbie Dyke now," he said.

"It won't be a big field and she would be a strong chance to run second to the great mare (Melody Belle) again.

"Who knows, if she leaves the barrier well, she might get even closer as she has been yearning for 2000m.

"From there she can have a freshen-up then maybe have a crack at the Breeders' Stakes (Gr.1, 1600m) against

her own sex at Te Aroha in April."

While Sharrock enjoyed a top night out with his fellow syndicate members who own Waisake, the win in the Trentham two-mile feature has thrown up some questions about where to head to next with the Zed gelding.

"We had thought about taking him to the Adelaide Cup (Gr.2, 3200m) but we're not so keen on that idea now," Sharrock said.

"With the COVID-19 restrictions and the quarantine, it's just not an attractive option to go there at the moment.

"I don't see him in the Auckland Cup (Gr.1, 3200m) so we might just have a run in the St Leger (Listed, 2600m) in March and then put him away until next season."

SOUTH ISLANDER GOES CLOSE TO MASSIVE CUP UPSET

Over the 147-year history of the Wellington Cup, the famous Trentham two-miler has witnessed any number of upset victories, but none would have been as great as the one that South Island stayer **Bluey's Chance (NZ)** (Remind) nearly pulled off on Saturday.

The Kenny Moore-trained seven-year-old went within a few strides of a remarkable win at odds in excess of \$150, succumbing to the late charge of race favourite Waisake (NZ) (Zed) in the final few strides and denying

Moore and apprentice rider Mereana Hudson a fairytale result.

Moore, who had earlier in the day produced \$49 winner Amazon Goddess (NZ) (Shamoline Warrior) at Riccarton, was far from disappointed with the result, preferring to reflect on a magnificent performance from his charge.

"It was a pretty amazing day," Moore said.

"I was actually really confident of a good run as long as he settled.

"We have two Bluey's Chances as

if he is out in the open, he will pull his head off but if he can get a good sit with some pace on then almost nothing will outstay him.

"We were just lucky that Mereana rode an absolute pearler and got him to settle even though he was in the open on the pace, where he would normally just pull all the way."

Moore had been looking for a rider for the Remind gelding for quite some time before having Hudson

recommended to him by Foxton trainer Suzy Gordon.

"We have had the horse staying with Suzy for the last three days and she recommended Mereana to us when I was trying to find a rider for him," he said.

"I had never met her before, but she has just got beautiful hands as she got him to relax so well.

"I don't think we could have asked for a better ride."

Moore admitted that his confidence started to rise as the race went on and when Bluey's Chance hit the front at the top of the straight, he began to dream of a famous victory.

"He is one of those remarkable horses that he doesn't care if it's wet,

dry, 1200m or two miles, he just goes his grand, honest race," he said.

"When he was in front turning in, I was just gob-smacked and couldn't believe what I was seeing.

"I actually became really confident as I just know how tough he is and he won't let anything past him without a real scrap.

"In the end I couldn't have been any happier than if he had won."

Moore, who began his training career in the standardbred industry back in the late 1990's before switching to thoroughbreds in 2017, races Bluey's Chance with harness trainer Dave Mitchell and Scotty Sutton, who is Moore's business partner in equine transport company

New Zealand Horse Transport.

It was Mitchell who purchased Bluey's Chance for just \$500 from the Long Acres Stud draft at the 2015 NZB South Island Sale.

"Dave bought him for \$500 which is a great story in itself," Moore said.

"When we got him, our main aim was to win a maiden race at Greymouth.

"We never dreamed we would end up in something like the Wellington Cup."

While Moore was overjoyed with his Wellington Cup day experience, he was also feeling satisfied he could provide Australian-based owner and breeder Kirk Devers with a win on his birthday with Amazon Goddess.

"She (Amazon Goddess) is a very nice mare and it was extra special for her owner Kirk Devers," Moore said.

"I've got six or seven horses in the stable for Kirk and it was his 50th birthday on Saturday.

"All he wanted was a win on his birthday and we managed to do that for him."

LOCAL GALLOPER IMPRESSES AT PUKEKOHE

Local runner **El Tirador (NZ)** (Shocking) provided a dashing display on his home track at Pukekohe on Sunday when he strode home to defeat his age-group rivals over 1400m.

The three-year-old son of Shocking made it back-to-back victories after opening his winning account narrowly at Ruakaka over 1200m earlier in the month.

The Nigel Tiley-trained galloper appreciated the rise in distance as he stalked pacemaker and race favourite Opalescence (NZ) (Showcasing) throughout before issuing his challenge early in the run home.

Under a confident ride by Saturday's Gr.3 Wellington Cup (3200m) winning jockey Sam Collett, El Tirador dashed clear at the 150m to win comfortably from Opalescence, who battled on well for second ahead of fellow pacemaker Macs (NZ) (Power).

El Tirador holds a nomination for the Gr.1 Vodafone New Zealand Derby (2400m) in March but Tiley isn't convinced that is a natural target for him.

"He still wants to go a little bit keen, but he was very strong at the line today," Tiley said.

"Once he got to the front and lengthened out, he was very good and that is no slug (Opalescence) that he has beaten.

"He is Derby nominated and they are only three once, but at the moment a mile would probably see him out.

"If he happened to win over a mile and his owners wanted to have a crack at the Derby then we've got nothing to lose.

"To be honest I haven't really looked past today for him, but we will see how he pulls up.

"He is a good doer and eats pretty well, so I expect him to bounce through this one nicely."

Bred and raced by a large group of owners, El Tirador is out of the unraced Captain Rio mare Pamela Place. His grand-dam is Centaine mare Our Centasea, a half-sister to dual Group One winner Seascay and the dam of Gr.1 BMW Stakes (2400m) and Gr.1 Turnbull Stakes (2000m) winner Littorio.
