## TALLYHO SURVIVES PROTEST TO WIN



Tallyho Twinkletoe (NZ) jumps on the first lap of the Brendan Dreschler Hurdle (Ross Holburt)

**N**ew Zealand jumper **Tallyho Twinkletoe (NZ)** (St Reims) survived a protest for late interference to maintain his unbeaten record in Australia when a brave but narrow winner of the Dreschler Hurdle (3500m) at Pakenham on Sunday.

The dual Grand National winner of last season will be set on the same path over the next few weeks after his victory which came after he shifted in late as **Bee Tee Junior (NZ)** (Nom Du Jeu) was finishing hard on his inside.

Backed heavily into \$1.60 by the time the field jumped away, Tallyho Twinkletoe looked set for a soft win turning for home but was made to work by Bee Tee Junior who had to move off his line late in the race as Tallyho Twinkletoe moved in late.

The son of St Reims gave six kilograms away to the runner-up and was jumping from 2400m to 3500m but still had enough in reserve to hang on.

He had just a narrow margin on the line from the \$13 chance with the second favourite Gobstopper (NZ) (Tavistock) tiring over the concluding stages for third, some 10 lengths away.

The nine-year-old Kiwi has only been at trainer Patrick Payne's property for the past week after returning to jumps racing for trainer Kevin Myers back home where he lumped 74 kilograms to victory in a steeplechase at Wanganui earlier this month.

"It was great to watch when he loomed up 100m out and he looked home but you never go the early crow as he (Bee Tee Junior) got very close

on the line," trainer Patrick Payne told Racing.com.

Tallyho Twinkletoe has run just twice previously in Australia when he strolled home in last year's Grand National Hurdle (4200m) and Grand National Steeplechase (4500m).

He will attempt to defend both titles this year with the Grand National Hurdle at Sandown on August 2 with the Grand National Steeplechase at Ballarat three weeks later.

Payne made it a feature race double less than an hour later when stable favourite **Slowpoke Rodriguez (NZ) (Istidaad)** broke a lengthy run of outs

to win the Mosstrooper Steeplechase (3500m).

The rising 10-year-old outlasted stablemate Killarney Kid (NZ) (Pendragon), with Amy McDonald's veteran chaser Felix Bay (Song Of Tara) closing into third.

### Ihaka breaks Aussie maiden

Winner winner, chicken dinner.

That's what Tony Ihaka was thinking after he notched a breakthrough Australian success on Sunday with a popular victory aboard emerging hurdler **Wolfe Tone (NZ) (Mettre En Jeu)** at Pakenham.

Ihaka, the former New Zealand jumps jockey who returned to race riding in May after more than six years off the scene, said he'd just tucked into a bucket of fried chicken when trainer Francis Finnegan called to book him for Sunday's ride.

He said it was a relief to finally open his Australian account.

"I've been schooling Wolfe Tone for a few years now and a couple of weeks ago Francis rang me - I was at the KFC drive-through actually getting a couple of buckets of chicken - and he asked how my weight was," Ihaka said.

"I looked at the KFC bucket and said it won't be too bad after this.

"It's my first win over here, thank god, it's good to shake that monkey off my back.

"It meant a lot that one, especially with Wolfe Tone, he did it all out there himself.

"I steered the ship and he sailed the sails."

Ihaka rode 40 winners in New Zealand between 2003 and 2014 but his career was plagued by a series of injuries and suspensions.

Since moving to Australia, he's ridden trackwork at Cranbourne and, more recently, Pakenham where he is based with champion trainer Peter Moody.

# BOOKMAKERS CONCEDE JOCKEYS' PREMIERSHIP TO ALLPRESS

**T**AB bookmakers have put up the white flag and are paying out on Lisa Allpress winning the National Jockeys' premiership.

A double aboard **Happy Star (NZ)** (Fabulous) and **Penelope Cruise (NZ)** (Ocean Park) at Awapuni on Saturday put her twelve wins clear of nearest rival Kozzi Asano with just two weeks and seven meetings left in a season tipped upside down by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Allpress is delighted to sit atop the premiership once again, the fourth time in a career that began back in the 1995/96 season when she began an apprenticeship with master trainer Kevin Gray.

Over the ensuing twenty four years she has amassed 1593 New Zealand victories along with over 100 international wins from riding stints in Singapore, Japan and most recently a history making victory in Saudi Arabia during an international invitational series in March, where she became the first female jockey to win in the Kingdom.

Despite her premiership success this season Allpress is adamant that wasn't her priority from the start.

"It's one of those things that wasn't in the plan at the start of the season," she said.

"I just kept whacking away and managed to get on some nice horses that kept winning."

"I really had just set out to try and get on some nice horses out of the trials and jumpouts and following them through to the races which was working nicely.

"I was going fairly well leading into my trip away to Saudi Arabia so I decided to get Aidan Rodley, my agent, to help me finish off the season well so it has definitely been a combined effort with him."

Amongst her New Zealand career victories are 96 at stakes level, a figure that Allpress is keen to see reach the 100 mark over the next twelve months along with several more personal goals she has set for herself.

"It is definitely a goal to get to 100 stakes wins so hopefully I can do that this season," she said.

"I've also got several trainers that I am getting close to riding 100 winners for so that would be really special if I could do that too."

"They include Michael Pitman, Wayne Marshment and my first boss, Kevin Gray, so I would really like to get that done.

"I'd like to think that achievement reflects the loyalty we have had for each other since I started as they are stables I

have ridden for ever since I first started."

While Allpress would also dearly love to defend her premiership title she is relaxed about her prospects for next season.

"I'm not really sure what is going to happen next season but I know there are some really lovely young horses coming through that I am keen to be involved with," she said.

"Mr Gray and John Benner and Hollie Wynyard have some really nice youngsters I'd like to ride when they get up and running."

"It will definitely be a quieter start for me though which I'm looking forward to and I will just take things as they come."

Allpress was back in action at Timaru on Sunday where a brilliant winning quartet aboard the Terri Rae-trained Paint Me Red (NZ) (Battle Paint), Scarfi (NZ) (Makfi), Hatrick Boys (NZ) (Makfi) and Newmarket (NZ) (Reliable Man) extended her lead over Asano to fifteen after the apprentice was successful on Reliably Perky (NZ) (Reliable Man) earlier in the day.

# THE GIFT THAT KEEPS GIVING FOR MASON

Well-travelled galloper **My Gift** (Notnowcato) bounced back to winning form on his favourite track when he dominated his rivals over the closing stages of Saturday's feature race at Awapuni, the John Turkington Forestry Ltd Rangitikei Gold Cup (2100m).

The rising eight-year-old won his first three races in Europe before an unsuccessful 19-race stint in Hong Kong was ended when he was sent back to New Zealand and the care of Te Aroha trainer Gary Hennessy.

Hennessy offered My Gift to owner-trainer John Mason who had lost the services of promising maiden Guess Who (NZ) (Bullbars) when he broke down badly during a race at Tauranga. Mason gratefully accepted the offer and was duly rewarded when the horse won over 1600m Te Aroha at just his fourth start for the Tokoroa trainer.

My Gift has gone on to put together a solid record, winning on seven further occasions including three from five starts at Awapuni.

"He's a pretty good horse and probably right up to the best around," Mason said.

"Like a lot of those horses that come back from Hong Kong it's a matter of keeping them from reverting to any bad habits they might have picked up and we've managed to do that with this guy.

"He normally takes a couple of starts to get race fit and that was his third run on Saturday so I thought he was thereabouts.

"He works on the grass track we've got at home so it takes a while to get them to peak but after his last start where Craig Grylls rode him, he got off and told me he would go pretty close next time.

"He had to be good on Saturday as they rode against him a little but once he got into the clear he was strong to the finish."

After being allocated topweight of 63kgs when the fields were announced, Mason took the opportunity of putting four kilogram-claiming apprentice Mubs Kareem aboard and was pleased with the way the young rider handled the occasion.

"I wanted to get a claim off his back so I asked Noel Harris to help me out and he got the lad for me," Mason said.

"You just can't win when your giving up to 8kgs away to the bottom weights so I knew I wanted to claim."

"I didn't know too much about him (Kareem) but he did a good job and rode him just how I asked."

Mason is undecided about where to go next with My Gift although he is keen to tackle some of the better races in the spring.

"I think he is good enough to win a Group race," he said.

"He ran second to Peso at Hastings last season off a tough run and he went on and ran a placing behind Melody Belle in the Group One later in that carnival so the form stacks up okay.

"He backs up well so we can look at what is coming up and take it one race at a time from there.

"He can handle most tracks as he has won on Heavy through to Dead so there should be something in the spring that will suit him." – **NZ Racing Desk**

# FOUR FOR RAE AT TIMARU

Riccarton trainer Terri Rae made her way to Timaru on Sunday with high hopes of a good showing from her eight-strong team but even she was blown away by the day's final winning tally.

**Victories to Paint Me Red (NZ)** (Battle Paint), **Scarfí (NZ)** (Makfi), **Hatrix Boys (NZ)** (Makfi) and **Newmarket (NZ)** (Reliable Man) gave Rae a winning quartet in partnership with National Jockeys' premiership leader Lisa Allpress, who was aboard all four successful runners.

Rae was beaming as she made her way back to Christchurch although she

admitted her confidence took a knock when race favourite Razor (NZ) (Roc de Cambes) was beaten into second in the first race on the card.

"I knew the team was well so I thought I might be able to win three but when Razor got beaten in the first, I started to have second thoughts," Rae said.

"Paint Me Red did win nicely in race two though and that got us on a roll but to win four was an unexpected but really special result for the day."

All four of the Rae winners look to have further victories in them including former northern mare Scarfi

who backed up from finishing sixth at Riccarton on an unsuitable heavy surface last month to race away from her rivals in a rating 83 1200m contest.

"She (Scarfí) has had just the two starts for me and she wasn't really suited first-up as the track was very tough that day," she said.

"She got bogged down at Riccarton but it was also a much tougher field than she met today, so her task was a little easier."

"They seem to have missed a lot of the bad weather that Christchurch has had of late as the track was very

good today even though it was rated a Slow9.

"She was sent down here to see if she could pick up some black type so I know her owners will be pleased she has got that first win here under her belt.

"Apparently they are planning a trip down to see her race so that will be a big day when that happens."

Another who appreciated the soft track conditions was the lightly raced Hatrix Boys, who took out the rating 83 1600m contest in his first start for more than twelve months.

"Hatrix Boys trialled superbly at Rangiora on Tuesday so we were confident of a big race," Rae said.

"He has had a few issues and hiccups and doesn't like the firm tracks so he only had three starts in his last campaign.

"He has a lot of talent and will be

even more suited by getting over further so the 1600m was just perfect for him fresh-up.

"Newmarket looked like one of our best chances and she didn't disappoint with a super performance.

"She's not overly big or robust but she has plenty of ability and should be able to win another one fairly quickly I think."

The successful quartet of wins took Rae to 24 for the season and lifted her into the top 15 on the National Trainers' premiership.
