ANOTHER EXPLOSIVE WEEKEND FOR PASSIONATE KIWI BREEDER

Thoroughbred owner and breeder Luigi Muollo was celebrating another milestone on Saturday evening after star staying three-year-old colt **Explosive Jack** (NZ) (Jakkalberry) added another Derby trophy to his growing collection.

The son of Muollo's ill-fated stallion Jakkalberry raced away with Saturday's Gr.1 South Australian Derby (2500m), his third Derby win this season after earlier taking out the Listed Tasmanian Derby (2200m) along with the Gr.1 ATC Derby (2400m) at his previous start.

Jakkalberry became the foundation stallion at Novara Park when Muollo established the Cambridge-based operation in 2015 and sadly passed away in 2018 from a gut infection.

The loss of the European Group One winner and 2012 Gr.1 Melbourne Cup (3200m) placegetter was a bitter blow for Muollo, but one which he doesn't dwell on as he enjoys the success of his progeny on the racetrack, particularly those associated with the lineage of his initial broodmare, Explosive.

Explosive Jack is out of the Listed Castletown Stakes (1200m) winner Extra Explosive (NZ) (Ekraar), a daughter of Explosive (NZ) (Exploding Prospect), who has also produced outstanding Hong Kong-based galloper Pick Number One (NZ).

"It was really tough at the time when Jakkalberry passed away, but you just have to pick yourself up and move on," Muollo said.

"Fortunately, I've got ten mares from the Explosive family that are just on fire.

"It all started with Vin De Dance (NZ) (Roc De Cambes), who is out of Explosive Dancer, winning the New Zealand Derby in 2018 (Gr.1, 2400m) and then Pick Number One being the champion three-year-old griffin in Hong Kong.

"We've sunk a lot of money into our broodmare band in recent years, but those ten mares I have from the Explosive family will be very strategic for us in the years to come."

Like many in the thoroughbred industry, Muollo's passion

for racing and breeding came from his parents and especially his father.

"My father raced and bred horses all his life," he said.

"Like all youngsters we went to the races with him and got bitten by the bug.

"I remember when he had horses like Lord Revenir and Kingston Bay, who raced successfully here and in Australia at the Group One level.

"You get a taste for that and want to emulate it. My brother Tony has also been heavily involved in the industry and helped Chris Waller get established in Sydney.

"He was the best man at Chris' wedding and races a number of horses with him, while he has also supported me and helped in the growth of my stud.

"We chat every day about horses and we just love it."

While shaken by the loss of Jakkalberry, Muollo has continued to develop stallions at Novara Park with New Zealand's 2019 leading First Season Sire on earnings, winners and stakes-winners Sweynesse now in his sixth season at the Karapiro property while Staphanos, the son of champion Japanese stallion Deep Impact, will stand his third season there in 2021.

"If you look at the statistics for Sweynesse, they really are outstanding for stakes winners and performers to foals," Muollo said.

"We have some lovely two-year-olds and yearlings coming through and he has a very bright future,

"Staphanos has four individuals going through the ring at New Zealand Bloodstock's Weanling sale next week, so we are excited to see how they fare.

"We haven't put any of our weanlings in the sale as I'm still a little

uncertain about the border situation with the pandemic implications impacting on how many Australians might get here, but we will definitely have a good crop for the yearling sale next year.

"Staphanos served 108 mares in his first season and got 98 in foal, so he will have every chance."

While excited by the showing of Explosive Jack, Muollo went close to recording his own Australian stakes winner on Saturday when Sweynesse filly Signora Nera (NZ) finished second to fellow New Zealand-bred Grace And Harmony (NZ) (Sebring) in the Listed Gold Coast Bracelet (1800m), while he also bred and shares in the ownership of third placegetter Only Words (NZ), also by Sweynesse.

"Signora Nera went a super race and I think she is building to a good win," he said.

"She is off to the Doomben Roses (Gr.2, 2000m) in a fortnight and then on to the Queensland Oaks (Gr.1, 2200m) after that.

"Only Words is also going to the Roses as well, so I'm just working out whether I can make the time to get across there to watch them race.

"We've got four boys and at the moment Saturday sport takes up a large amount of our time, which I'm involved in and I love, but I did say to my wife we might have to consider it if we can find a few more hours in the day."

LATTA TRAINS 1000TH NEW ZEALAND WINNER

Abarnstorming late run by three-year-old filly **Platinum Star (NZ)** (Burgundy) that carried her to a maiden victory at Woodville on Sunday also brought up a special milestone for trainer Lisa Latta.

The victory was Latta's 1000th New Zealand career winner after she was encouraged to step out as a trainer in her own right following the death of her boss and mentor Malcolm Smith in 1998.

Latta trained five winners in her first solo season and has built an enviable record over the past 24 years through the deeds of quality gallopers such as Wharite Princess (NZ) (His Royal Highness), Fort Lincoln (Charge Forward), Mikki Street (NZ) (Cape Cross), Platinum Witness (California Witness), Platinum Invador (NZ) (Redwood) and Sentimental Miss (NZ) (Reliable Man).

Winning the National Trainers' premiership in the 2013/2014 season is one of many highlights for Latta, finishing runner-up the following season to Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman.

The Awapuni trainer has prepared the winners of 62 stakes races domestically, in addition to winning black-type races in Australia with the likes of Platinum Kingdom (Magnus) and Zennista (NZ) (Zenno Rob Roy).

To reach the 1000-win milestone is something Latta never contemplated when she took the decision to enter the trainers ranks on her own.

"I guess this has been a long time coming and it is more a feeling of relief to get the monkey off my back rather than anything else at the moment," she said.

"I'm not sure how long I was on 999 but it seems like forever."

"It was great to achieve the 1000 wins with a horse bred and part-owned by Neville McAlister, as he has played such a big part in my career."

"Neville and John and Lynne Street were right behind me when I started out and have been great supporters over all the years I have been training."

"I've just been really lucky to have had terrific and loyal owners, along with great staff, who have all played their part in getting to where we are today."

While I loathe to single out the best horse she has trained,

Latta reserves special mention for 2011 Karaka Million 2YO (1200m) winner Fort Lincoln.

"Fort Lincoln winning the Karaka Million was a very special day for the stable," she said.

"I would also say horses like Wharite Princess (Gr.1 New Zealand Oaks, 2400m), Platinum Witness (Gr.1 NZ 1000 Guineas, 1600m) and Authentic Paddy, who won eleven races, are some of the others that spring to mind."

Latta didn't have any special celebrations planned to mark her achievement, preferring a quiet evening after a long day at the Woodville meeting.

"I hadn't really thought about what I would do if we got the win, but I know it has been a really long day with eleven races at the meeting," she said.

"It might be nice to just go home and rest up before getting out of bed early tomorrow morning to do it all again."

NEWMAN ON A MISSION AFTER WINNING DOUBLE



Tegan Newman guides Rose 'N' Power to victory at Te Rapa (Trish Dunell)

Apprentice jockey Tegan Newman is well on her way to achieving the 'crazy' goal she set herself when she returned to the saddle last year after recovering from a major injury.

The personable twenty-five-year-old was off the racing scene for four months after suffering serious back and chest injuries in a trackwork incident.

Since making her return Newman has gained steady momentum with a winning double aboard the Fred and Lindsay Cornege-trained Rose 'N' Power (NZ) (Power) and the Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained Crafty Jess (NZ) (Mastercraftsman) at Te Rapa on Saturday taking her tally for the season to 29 victories and 57 lifetime wins overall.

Newman is determined to outride

the two-kilogram claim she currently enjoys before her apprenticeship ends in September.

"When I came back from my injury, I set myself a crazy goal to outride my two-kilogram claim before I come out of my apprenticeship," she said.

"I need 23 more wins to do that which seems like a bit of a mountain to climb but I'm hoping I can do that if I

can keep getting on some of the nice horses I have been riding lately.

"I've never ridden for the Corneges or for Murray and Andrew before, so to be able to get a ride for them and to win was really satisfying.

"It was also pretty ironic that when I won on Crafty Jess, I beat Sam Collett (Ranger) and Danielle Johnson (Germanicus) who have been wonderful mentors for me since I started riding.

"To beat them was a thrill and they were great about it afterwards, although I copped a bit of banter in the jockeys' room."

While Newman is taking a single-minded focus on achieving her goal, she has a constant reminder of the dangers of her chosen profession each time she climbs into the saddle.

"I still have the injuries I received in my bad fall niggling away at me," she said.

"I go to physiotherapy once a week, but I still get pain in my back and chest as they haven't properly diagnosed the root cause of the discomfort.

"I tend to get a sharp pain in my lower back as well as tightening in my chest.

"I am on some pills for it, but I'm

going to another specialist as the original one hasn't been able to work it all out.

"I did have some cortisone injections, but they didn't work, so hopefully the new specialist can work it all out for me."

Newman also admitted she didn't realize that jockeys Johnathan Parkes and Masa Hashizume had come to grief in a fall in the home straight during the race won by Crafty Jess.

"I was concentrating on getting to the line with Crafty Jess and didn't realize there had been a fall until Danielle said something when we were pulling up," she said.

"When I was heading back to the birdcage, I saw the two riderless horses, so I was just hoping everyone was going to be okay.

"It does remind you we are in a dangerous business, but I love what I do and want to keep going for as long as I can.

"I'm not sure what lies ahead when I finish my apprenticeship, but if I can keep getting rides then I want to see just how far I can go."

MISS RICKY BOBBY BACK TO WINNING FORM AT WOODVILLE

A change of environment worked the oracle for talented mare **Miss Ricky Bobby (NZ)** (High Chaparral) as she produced a strong front-running performance to take out the opening event at Woodville on Sunday.

The five-year-old daughter of High Chaparral was making her debut from the Johno Benner and Hollie Wynyard stable and never gave her rivals a look in under the urgings of Lisa Allpress.

Unsighted since her last run at Pukekohe back in October last year when prepared by Nigel Tiley, Miss Ricky Bobby set a steady tempo out in front before Allpress booted her clear in the run home to win by nearly two lengths from race favourite Rabada (NZ) (Per Incanto).

Benner admitted to feeling a great deal of satisfaction with the victory.

"It was very satisfying as she is a lovely mare," he said.

"With Nigel scaling back his training operation, her owners sent her down to us with a couple of their other horses.

"Nigel had her in good order and had done four or five weeks with her, so we just picked up where he left off.

"She's very capable and has a lovely pedigree, so that win will help her along later on when she heads to the broodmare paddock.

"She was a two-win horse in the rating 65 grade so she was well placed and she has a fair bit of ability, so we thought she would be hard to beat if she could reproduce the form she had earlier in her career."

Raced by Graeme and Leah Causer under their Aspen Bloodstock banner, Miss Ricky Bobby has now won three of her 10 starts with Benner keen to see her extend that record.

"She's not a true wet tracker so she will probably have one more start before we put her aside for a winter break," he said.

"I don't think there is any reason why she can't kick on as she is very versatile and is above average.

"She's very sound but has just taken time to mature, but the way she won today I think she could be on the verge of

some black type form if she keeps on improving."

While Benner and Wynyard have lost the services of some of their stars this season such as Bonham (Per Incanto), Montre Moi (NZ) (Showcasing), Meg (Sebring) and Wononeohwon (NZ) (Tavistock), who have all been sold, Benner is confident they have a good winter team ahead of them as well as some very promising youngsters in the stable.

"We have some lovely horses for the winter including Happy Star and Crowning Star, who look well placed in some of the better races coming up," he said.

"We have certainly lost some firepower as we do trade a lot of horses, but I'm confident that we have some coming through that can take their place next season."

After riding an early double, top rider Lisa Allpress was stood down after suffering a head knock on late scratching Castani (NZ) (Per Incanto) in race six.
